Explanatory Notes

Supreme Court Rules 22(h) authorizes this court to adopt rules that are consistent with the Illinois Supreme Court Rules and Illinois statutes. The Uniform Administrative and Procedural Rules Appellate Courts Second, Third, Fourth, and Fifth Districts (the Uniform Administrative Rules) also provide rules for this court. To facilitate the administration of justice, the Illinois Appellate Court, Second District (the Court), hereby enacts the following rules (the Local Rules) in addition to the Supreme Court Rules and the Uniform Administrative Rules. In the event of a conflict, the Supreme Court Rules and the Uniform Administrative Rules shall control. All prior rules issued by the Court are hereby rescinded.

These Local Rules are set forth to facilitate the administration of justice in the Court. The Court may at its discretion alter, suspend, rescind, or waive these Local Rules, in whole or in part, as the ends of justice require.
