

14. Disposition of Accelerated Cases

Where no appellee brief is timely filed, an accelerated case will be considered ready for submission seven days after the appellant's brief is filed, unless a timely motion for extension of time to file the appellee brief is filed. If a timely motion for extension of time is filed but no appellee brief is subsequently timely filed, the case will be considered ready for disposition seven days after the due date determined by the resolution of the motion or motions for extension of time.

All other accelerated cases will be considered ready for disposition upon the timely filing of the appellant reply brief (or cross-reply brief, if applicable). Where no reply brief (or cross-reply brief) is timely filed, a case will be considered ready for disposition on the due date for the reply brief (or cross-reply brief) unless a timely motion for extension of time is filed.

If a timely motion for extension is filed but no reply brief (or cross-reply brief) is subsequently timely filed, the case will be considered ready for submission as of the due date determined by the resolution of the motion or motions for extension of time.
