NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING - December 10, 2012

In accordance with Supreme Court Rule 3 (Rulemaking Procedures), you are hereby notified that the Supreme Court Rules Committee will hold a public hearing on **Monday, December 10, 2012**, beginning at **10 a.m.**, in Room C-500 at the Michael A. Bilandic Building, 160 N. LaSalle Street, in Chicago. Clerks of court are requested to post a hard copy of this notice in a conspicuous place.

The following proposals are on the public hearing agenda: (1) 12-01 (P.R. 0196) Creates a new Supreme Court Rule regarding defendant's appearance by closed circuit television and video conference; (2) 12-02 (P.R. 0197) Creates new Supreme Court Rule 275 (Stay of Proceedings to Enforce a Judgement and amends Rule 305 (Stay of Judgment Pending Appeal); (3) 12-03 (P.R. 0198) Amends Supreme Court Rule 315 (Leave to Appeal From the Appellate Court to the Supreme Court); (4) 12-05 (P.R. 0200) Amends Supreme Court Rule 216 (Admission of Fact or of Genuineness of Documents); (5) 12-06 (P.R. 0201) Creates a new Supreme Court Rule 660A providing for expedited appeals from final judgments in delinquent minor proceedings arising under the Juvenile Court Act; and (6) 12-08 (P.R. 0203)Amends Supreme Court Rule 608 (The Record on Appeal).
